- 15 students at Western from COTTFN and well supported.
- Jody Noah Co-Chair and Munsee -Delaware update
 - Policy review in October; attended by Laura and Debbie. Just had approval to increasing running allowance amount for students. Retro back to start of winter.
 - Engagement with AFN chiefs of Ontario and AIAI;
 - Online database started for fall term last year. Students able to apply online.
 - Wellness checks and virtual check-ins with students. Has been okay but wishing for more participants
 - New system for sending sponsorship letters
