### 4. Policy for Affirming Declarations of Indigeneity at Western University- IPEC Co-chairs present

- Draft iteration number two is currently being reviewed by a legal team
- Has been piloted six times by the Indigenous Identity Affirmation Council
- IFAC members have agreed to submit to Identity affirming policy
- Question- what are the modes of affirmation for global Indigenous individuals?
- For consideration- genealogy tree, currently expressed as 'four generations out' Is this too much to represent a close tie to community?
- Motion was made to approve the policy with stipulation that the document continues to be a live document.
- Policy proceeds to Senate after review by legal

### 5. IPEC workplan discussion- IPEC co-chair Jody Noah

- A work plan should be better developed to guide the work of the IPEC team. As it stands in previous years, there was a specific focus on departments or units such as Schulich Medicine to best understand needs and assess where decolonial method can be applied.
